

Internships

During an internship a student works on one or more of the research subjects stated in the next chapters. At the same time the student gets the possibility to experience how it is to work at an engineering company by helping the project- and engineering department. The student is stimulated to join inspections and visit full scale plants.

Internships are preferred to last about 4-6 months. Shorter or longer periods may be possible on request.

Trainees/ Junior engineer

During an traineeship a newly graduate is given the position of “PhD” within the company. The trainee get its own research project and the means to develop the project with his or her own ideas. At the same time the trainee will be introduced into the field of environmental engineering. She or he will learn all knowledge available at DMT about waste water treatment, air pollution control and biogas treatment. A trainee will join inspections and start-ups of DMT plants. A trainee is stimulated to explore her/ his ideas and apply them on DMT products. After an internship a Junior Engineer position at DMT is one of the possibilities.

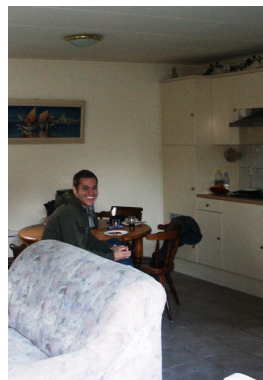
A traineeship last about 1 year. 6 months pure research/ 6 months research and engineering.
